In Sainsbury's Supermarkets you'll receive 1 voucher for every £10 you spend. So if you spend £40 you'll get four vouchers, but what's new is that they'll all be printed on one piece of paper. These vouchers are white and smaller in size, with no photograph on them. Once you've collected your vouchers, drop them off in the Sainsbury's voucher box within the main reception at St Peter's.
