### Newsletter/website.

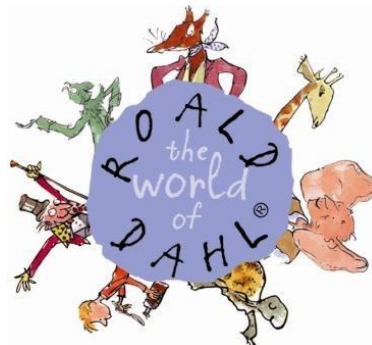
Firstly thank you to those of you who read this every week. We put it on the website and email it out to the emails we have for you.

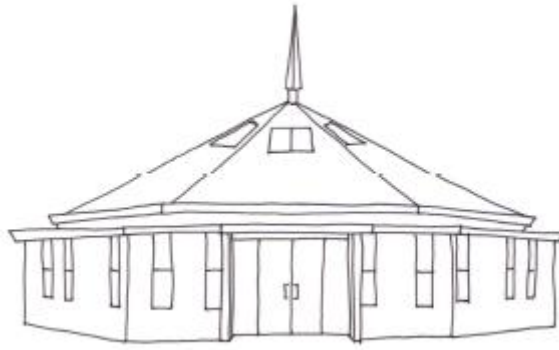
### Reading help.

### **GOD'S MERCY IS FROM AGE TO AGE** ***The mercy of God in the Old Testament***

Since the early centuries of Christianity God has sometimes been understood as cruel and vindictive. This study day explores the presence of God's mercy in the Old Testament, revealing that God is forgiving and compassionate, and a model for the mercy we must show to others.

Rev Dr Adrian Graffy is parish priest of Gidea Park, Essex. He is Chair of the National Scripture Group at the Bishops' Conference, and in 2014 was appointed by Pope Francis as a member of the Pontifical Biblical Commission.
