November 4th - 31st Sunday in Ordinary Time
Jesus gives us in this Gospel the greatest commandment.

November 11th - 32nd Sunday in Ordinary Time
We learn the parable of the widow and the coins.

November 18th - 33rd Sunday in Ordinary Time
Jesus tells the disciples about the signs of his second coming.

November 25th - Solemnity of Christ the King
In this Gospel we learn of the exchange between Pilate and Jesus.
