Contact Information

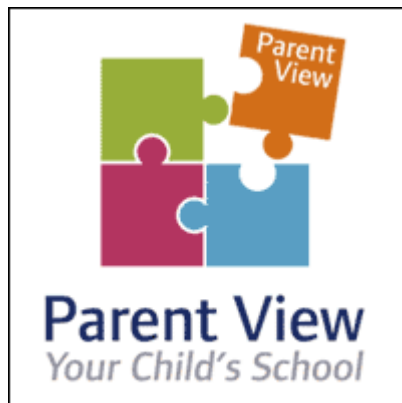
Please make sure you keep us updated in any changes to addresses, emails and telephone numbers.
