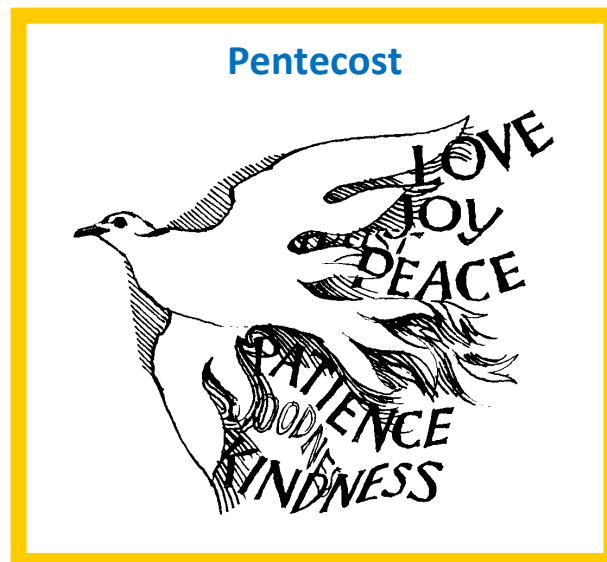
Party Bags
