

## Home Learning Tasks – Year 6

**Week beginning: 23/3/19**

### **English tasks:**

- Write a letter from Karl to his Mum (Clockwork character) telling her how nervous he is about the great clock reveal. Include his thoughts, feelings and emotions.
- Read an age appropriate book from home for 30 minutes. Storyboard and sequence the main events of the story into 8 boxes. Draw a picture and create a commentary for each box.
- Read an age appropriate book from home for 25 minutes. Write a one paragraph summary of the book detailing all that happens. Create five questions for each of the VIPER reading skills – Vocabulary, Infer, Predict, Explain, Retrieve, Summarise.
- Create five grammar flash cards. Cut a piece of A4 in half and then create a revision poster on an element of grammar from your CGP book. Include top tips, key facts and examples.
- Create a 20 minute grammar test for yourself on areas of grammar you need to practise. This should have 10 questions on and be completed by you. Add 10 spellings onto this to create a 20 minute test.

### **Maths Tasks:**

- In your CGP Maths revision book, find a topic you want to practise. Alter the questions to create a set of questions for you to answer and then mark.
- Create 30 different arithmetic questions based on Addition, Subtraction, Multiplication, Division and Fractions.
- Go onto Mathletics and complete five reasoning tasks.
- Go onto BBC bitesize and revise a topic of your choosing. Complete the tasks at the bottom of the page and play the learning games provided.
- Create five Maths flash cards. Cut a piece of A4 in half and then create a revision poster on an element of Maths from your CGP book. Include top tips, key facts and examples.

### **'Other' Task:**

**RE:** Diary Entry from Martha (Lazarus' sister) detailing how Lazarus was raised and the emotion she felt around Jesus raising Lazarus from the dead.

**History:** Research Thomas Barnando and create a fact file about him. The headings should be: Early Life, Homes for Poor Children, What does his charity do now?

**Science:** Classifying living animals. Children to research Vertebrate and Invertebrate animals. Children to create a classification table. List the features of one animal from the following classifications: Anthropods, Molluscs, Reptiles, Mammals and Amphibians.

**PSHE:** Dealing with anxiety. Children to create a top tips poster based on helping people deal with anxiety and how they can be happy again.

**Art:** Research and recreate a piece of William Morris' (Victorian artist) work.

**DT:** Design and create your own Victorian currency! Create a gold coin and a note dedicated to important people from the Victorian times. Design on a sheet of paper and create with anything in the house, such as a cereal box.

**PE:** Go onto Youtube and search 'Cosmic Kids Yoga.' Take part in the Yoga Class and then do a cool down for 10 minutes afterwards.
